

Select rock garden plants and their uses

Common name	Botanical name	Characteristics	Uses
Variigated rock cress	<i>Arabis fernandi-coburgi variegata</i>	2" mat, white margin on leaves, white flowers on 6" stems	Groundcover, crevices, walls (S-PtS)
False rock cress	<i>Aubrieta deltoidea</i>	3" dense mat, purple to red flowers on 6" stems	Groundcover; hanging over walls, rocks (S-PtS)
Gold dust alyssum	<i>Aurinia saxatilis 'Gold Dust'</i>	4" bluish-green leaves, bright yellow flowers	Tops of walls (S)
Creeping broom	<i>Cytisus procumbens</i>	2" tall, trailing, cascading; yellow flowers	Groundcover; hanging over walls, rocks (S)
Mini Kenilworth ivy	<i>Cymbalaria muralis 'Nana'</i>	1" spreading, tiny leaves, pink flowers	Groundcover, crevices, walls (PtS-Shd)
Dalmatian bellflower	<i>Campanula portenschlagiana</i>	2" dense mat, blue-purple flowers on 3" stems	Groundcover, walls (S-PtS)
Ice plant	<i>Delosperma nubigenum 'Basutoland'</i>	succulent, 1" mat, yellow flowers	Groundcover, walls, crevices (S)
Garden pink	<i>Dianthus alpinus 'Tiny Rubies'</i>	2" grass-like leaves, bright-pink flowers on 4" stems	Groundcover (S)
Red-leaf geranium	<i>Geranium sessiliflorum ssp. novium rubrum</i>	3" clump of reddish leaves, white flowers	Groundcover, tops of walls (S-PtS)
Pine-leaf penstemon	<i>Penstemon pinifolius</i>	6-8" "piney" shrub, bright red (or yellow) tubular flowers	Walls, crevices (S)
Winter savory	<i>Satureja montana (or spinosa) 'Nana'</i>	6" tiny-leaved shrub, white flowers	Groundcover, walls, crevices (S)
Hen-and-chicks	<i>Sempervivum</i> sps.	succulent 1-3" globes of green and reddish leaves	Walls, crevices (S-PtS)
Stonecrops	<i>Sedum dasyphyllum</i>	1" tiny, succulent blue-green leaves, white flowers	Groundcover, walls, crevices (S)
Stonecrops	<i>S. spurium 'Tricolor'</i>	2" colorful, succulent pink-white-green leaves, pink flowers	Walls, crevices (S)
Veronica (Turkish)	<i>Veronica liwanensis</i>	1" tall with tiny green leaves, blue flowers	Groundcover, walls, crevices (S)
Veronica (creeping)	<i>V. repens 'Sunshine'</i>	1" with yellow-green leaves, white flowers	Groundcover, walls, crevices (S)

(S)=sun; (PtS)=part sun; (PtShd)=part shade; (Shd)=shade. Note: all of these have at least a USDA Hardiness Zone 5 rating
