1992 Index

This index was compiled to assist the reader in finding information in the 1992 issues of *Garden Railways* magazine. It covers six issues, from January-February 1992 through November-December 1992. There are over 350 entries, cross-referenced by article title, author's name, and subject matter. We have made this index as complete as possible and we regret any inadvertent omissions or errors.

Using the index

All categories are delineated as follows:

The AUTHOR'S LAST NAME is in capital letters. Below the author's name is a listing of his/her article(s).

The **Article Titles** are all in boldface type and are listed both under the author's name and alphabetically within the index.

The Subject listings are all entered in plain type and may include subentries.

At the end of each listing you will find numbers, such as 9/3 24. The first digit is the volume, the digit after the slash is the issue number, and the last number is the page on which the article begins. The above example would translate as volume 9 (1992), number 3 (May-June), page 24.

The Product Review Index

Also included is a supplemental index of all products reviewed in *GR* during 1992. It is cross-referenced by the type of product and the manufacturer. The manufacturer's name is in **boldface type** while the products are listed in plain type. After each entry is the volume and issue number.
